### Introduction

### **Daily Activities**

# Morning Circle Time (9:00 - 9:30 AM)

- Welcome song
- Attendance check
- Review of the day's theme
- Story Time

**Description:** Start the day with a fun and engaging circle time. We'll sing familiar songs, take attendance, and introduce the day's theme through interactive storytelling. This is a great way to build a sense of community and prepare toddlers for the day's activities.

**Materials:** Theme-related storybook, attendance chart, song lyrics.

### Activity 1: Sensory Play (9:30 - 10:00 AM)

 Specific sensory activity, e.g., Water table with floating toys, playdough with cookie cutters, sand box with shovels **Description:** Explore the world through touch, sight, smell, and sound! Sensory play stimulates creativity, problem-solving skills, and fine motor development.

#### Outdoor Play (11:30 AM -12:00 PM)

- Free play in the playground

#### Lunch Time (12:00 - 12:30 PM)

 Nutritious lunch (provided by parents) **Description:** A time to refuel and socialize. We encourage toddlers to try new foods and practice good table manners.

Materials: Lunch boxes, napkins.

#### Quiet Time/Story Time (12:30 -1:00 PM)

- Reading books
- Quiet activities (e.g., puzzles, building blocks)

**Description:** A time for relaxation and quiet reflection. Reading books and engaging in quiet activities helps toddlers calm down and prepare for nap time.

Materials: Books, puzzles, building blocks.

#### Nap Time (1:00 - 3:00 PM)

Rest and relaxation

**Description:** A crucial time for toddlers to rest and recharge, promoting healthy development and well-being.

Materials: Cots, blankets, pillows.

# Free Play/Afternoon Activities (3:00 - 4:00 PM)

- Free play with toys and games
